Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Announces a Public Information Open House for the Suncoast Parkway 2 Project

Land O'Lakes (July 18, 2008)—Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) has scheduled a Public Information Meeting for Thursday, July 24, 2008 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the National Guard Armory, located at 8551 W. Venable Street, Crystal River. All those who are interested are invited to attend.

The meeting will inform the public of the progress of the design for the Suncoast Parkway 2 project. The Public Information Meeting will be conducted as an informal open house where the public may come anytime between the hours of 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to view maps, drawings and other information regarding the design and Project Development and Environment Reevaluation for the proposed alignment, interchange locations and configurations.

Representatives from Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will be available to discuss the

project and answer questions. Comments or suggestions can be given to Turnpike representatives at that time, or can be submitted in writing through completion of a comment form. This is not a public hearing. Later in the design process, a formal public hearing will be held to present the project's recommendations and record comments.

In the event that severe weather or other unforeseen conditions cause the meeting to be postponed, it will be held on the alternate date of August 7, 2008.
